C. Gordon Van Arman Scholarship

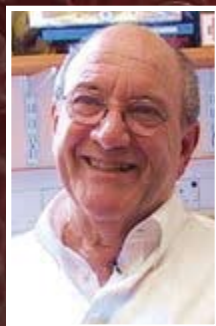
